Congratulations on your decision to run for local office this November. If you are interested in an endorsement from the California League of Conservation Voters (CLCV), or the Loma Prieta chapter of the Sierra Club, this letter outlines the process that we use to endorse candidates.

On August 1, we are holding a briefing for candidates on environmental issues. We hope you can join us to learn about issues that are important to us, as well as meet you informally. The briefing is at the Peninsula Conservation Center, 3921 E. Bayshore Road, Palo Alto 94303, which is near 101 and the San Antonio Road exit. The briefing is from 9 am to noon. If you could RSVP, we appreciate it, but more importantly, come join us!

Around August 10, we will send you a questionnaire and details about the endorsement process for your jurisdiction. Typically, the questionnaire response is due around August 24. We interview candidates who respond in the last week of August or first week in September. The CLCV and Sierra Club will each notify you of their endorsement decision around September 10-15.
